



How to join our Singing Mamas Community

If you've got a regular place reserved at the group then there are 2 things you need to do to officially join. First, complete a membership form and second, set up payment. You also have the option of joining our community WhatsApp group, though it's not obligatory (there are more details about that at the bottom along with term dates).

1. Membership form

We need everyone that joins to fill in a digital membership form so we have your details and emergency contact. It takes 2 - 3 minutes to complete by following the link below.

Your information is held on a secure password protected system and will be used to share important updates about the group you attend. It won't be passed on anywhere for marketing purposes and the data you give us will be securely disposed of when you leave the group in line with a GDPR policy.

You will also have the option on the form of signing up to the Singing Mamas Newsletter where you'll receive inspiration, songs and invitations to our national events (like retreats and a family festival).

2. Payment

Places at the group cost £5 (low income)/£8 (full price) /£10 (pay it forward) per week

or £22 per month (which equates to £7.50 per session over 32 weeks of the year).

We use a payment system on the Wix platform which is integrated with the website. All you need to do is follow the instructions on the booking system when you book in.

Visitors

We welcome the occasional visitor to the group where space allows. It's lovely when people drop by by-accident without booking! or if you bring a friend. The fee for this is £8.

Bursary Places

We want these groups to be available to every woman that needs them and recognise that payment can be a barrier. In order to try to balance fair access with the groups! viability we have committed to offering a limited number of bursary places for mamas whose circumstances meet the following criteria:

- Currently claiming PIP, JSA or ESA
- Have refugee or asylum seeker status
- Experiencing domestic abuse

3. WhatsApp
